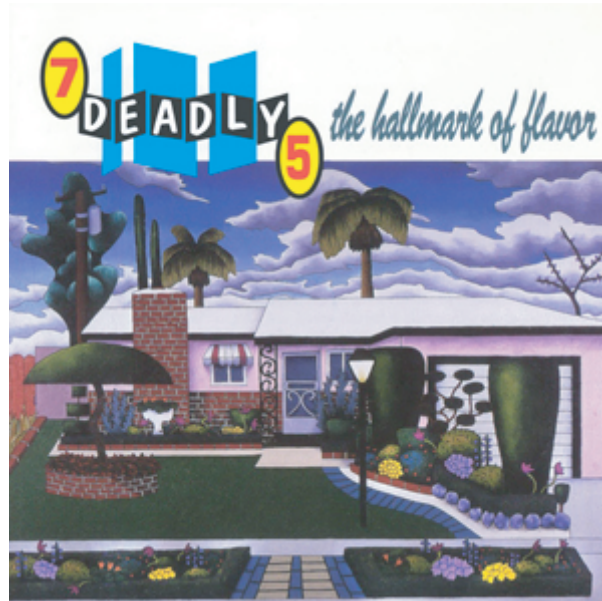

The band released one L.P. entitled "The Hallmark of Flavor" in 1995 on Indie label Velvetone Records.

Hatched in Eagle Rock Ca. this power pop gem didn't get all the attention it deserved when it arrived but good songs are good songs, and this L.P. is full of them. Fans of Mott The Hoople and T-Rex will love the stompy pop rockers and Beatles fans will dig the cool arrangements and instrumentation.
